Beauty Pageant of 1904 CANCELED

Yes, it's a sad day in Freeland. The eve before the big "Rodeo Extravaganza", the five contestants in the Annual Beauty Pageant were "Banned" from participating. Banned from the competition, for using "Seductive Aromas" to sway our distinguished judge's decision. The judge, our very own honorable Postmaster, Mr. Delmar Delaney, who has since been declared non-available. Reports have it, that while the festivities were getting under way on the side lot of the Freeland Hotel during the now infamous "Father Neptune's" dance segment, the judge appeared to be somewhat over taken from the fragrances exuding from our lovely pageant contestants. The good judge had gathered the gals closely around him, to demonstrate the latest dance craze sweeping the country, "The Kick-a-Poo". That's when the crowd started closing in around them, reciting old sea shanty's of encouragement. Well this carried on for a while, to the attendee's delight that is, until Mrs. Delaney arrived unannounced. When the judge looked up and saw the mother of his children glaring at him, his clothes disheveled and torn, his face became ashen. He must have felt a bit disoriented and a dizziness consumed him, apparently from those "seductive aroma's". The "mob" was too tightly crowded together for anyone to see what happened next, but as Mrs. Delaney pushed her way to the judge, a gasp arose from the array of on-lookers. Then a "hush" and some "murmurs" from all in attendance as the Judge, our Postmaster, Mr. Delmar Delaney, slumped to the ground.

Now as yet, Freeland does not have a vibrant "Fire and Rescue Team" available. However, who they do have is an Old Russian Cossack Medic recently moved to town from the homeland. Her voice was easily heard over the heads of everyone in attendance, that "Prudy Delila Delaney had way overstepped her authority. That pageant was mine to win!" Loretta's lack of compliance to the canceled pageant did not go unnoticed by Mrs. Delaney, who was now making her way towards Loretta Lee for a final confrontation. Mrs. Delaney was not only the Postmaster's wife, she was President of the P.T.A., Chairperson of the D.D.A., Head of Rodeo Affairs of Freeland, and Honorary Chief of the Local Indian Tribe. To say she was fed up, or even had a case of the, would be an understatement.

Had it not been for the intervention of Miss Iona Pudicaris, Chief Executive Officer of the Iocal "Teddy Roosevelt for President" republican campaign party displaying the skills of a politician. Miss Iona cut into the raging bull-like path of Mrs. Delaney and said, "Now Delila, let's not get our bustles all in a twist. We've got a fun weekend planned with the Rodeo, and all those bodacious cowboys in those tight chaps, ridin' those big nasty horses, with sweaty manure flyin' every whichaway. Let's not spoil it!"

"As part-time bible school teachers, we've both endured Mr. Beethoven's first four clamorous juveniles in class and Mr. Beethoven's fifth daughter is even more unrestrained. Mr. Beethoven is after all, older and as deaf as a door knob. She is clearly his last installment to the human race. Can't we all just get along?" With that being said, the steam slowly stopped rolling from Delila's ears, the storm cloud over her head dispersed, from somewhere in the back, a band started playing the "KickaPoo" song.
